

FY 2025 RSVP Overview of Programs

Foster Grandparent Program



Intergenerational program connecting older adults with children and youth.

Volunteers:

- Mentor and guide children and youth to higher academic achievement and social emotional development.
- Help children and youth succeed through one-on-one tutoring and/or mentorship.
- Provide consistent support from a caring adult giving children and youth the tools they need for success in academics and life.

Eligible volunteers may receive a small stipend to defray the costs of serving.





FY 2025 RSVP Overview of Programs

Senior Companion Program



A peer-to-peer program to help older adults live independently.

Volunteers:

- Provide respite to family caregivers.
- Support to older adults who have difficulty with daily tasks.
- Provide companionship to help reduce social isolation.
- Keep older adults engaged in their community and living in their home longer.
- Support opportunities to reduce the expense of long-term institutional care.

Eligible volunteers may receive a small stipend to defray the costs of serving.





FY 2025 RSVP Overview of Programs

RSVP Program




Senior volunteer program that meets local community needs.

Focus Areas: Disaster Services, Economic Opportunity, Education, Environmental Stewardship, Healthy Futures, and Veterans and Military Members.

Volunteers engage in service opportunities such as:

- food security,
- tax and benefits support,
- tutoring students of all ages,
- supporting veterans and military families,
- disaster support and conservation.

Volunteers do not receive a stipend, but may be reimbursed for meals, mileage, and other costs related to their service.





Overview of Programs

Senior Demonstration Program



- Demonstrate the power of older Americans as volunteers to make significant contributions within their communities.
- Allow funding of innovative programming and activities, such as:
 - Providing a pathway from service to employment.
 - Supporting native nations and indigenous elders in addressing community needs.

AmeriCorps Seniors

Workforce Development

- Supporting older adults in obtaining permanent employment in skilled labor and professional careers
- Providing training and certification for employment
- Receiving job search and placement support

About RSVP

Established in 1971 and now one of the largest senior volunteer programs in the nation, AmeriCorps Seniors RSVP engages people ages 58 and older in a diverse range of volunteer activities. AmeriCorps Seniors RSVP volunteers tutor children, help prepare simple taxes, assist victims of natural disasters, provide nutrition/food support, facilitate opioid and substance abuse education workshops, and serve in their communities in many other ways. AmeriCorps Seniors RSVP volunteers choose how, where, and how often they want to serve, with commitments ranging from a few hours to a maximum of 46 hours per week. While serving, AmeriCorps Seniors RSVP volunteers improve their own lives by staying active and civically engaged. To read the statute that regulates the AmeriCorps Seniors RSVP program, view the <u>Uniform Guidance § CFR 200</u>2 and RSVP Federal Regulations.


