

Appendix F: Cost per Volunteer Calculator for the AmeriCorps Seniors Native Nations and Indigenous Elders Senior Demonstration Program



Overview

Organizations applying for the AmeriCorps Seniors Native Nations & Indigenous Elders Senior Demonstration Program are asked to provide a justification for a cost per volunteer that is reasonable and necessary for the execution of the proposed program.

To determine the cost per volunteer, divide the amount of federal funding requested by the total number of volunteers you plan to recruit. Common arithmetic rules should be used to determine how to round cost per volunteer. Applicants should round to the nearest whole number. For example, an AmeriCorps Seniors applicant requesting \$210,850 in federal funding with 75 volunteers would have a cost per volunteer of \$2,811 ($210,850/75 = 2811.3$). An applicant requesting \$467,825 in federal funding with 50 volunteers would have a cost per volunteer of \$9,357 ($467,825/50 = 9365.5$). **These examples are for illustration only and are not meant to provide guidelines for the cost per volunteer.**
