Please see our [suggested guidance](#) on how to align your narrative to the eGrants fields. Enter the narrative specified in the Notice into the following eGrants categories (see table below):

- **Project Information, Community Background, Research Objectives and Literature Review** into eGrants *Research Objectives, Background and Conceptual Framework*
- **Preliminary Research Design, Action Plans, Work Plan and Justification of Timeline, Community Involvement and Participatory Research Approach** into eGrants *Research Design and Work Plan*
- **N/A** into the Dissemination Plan subcategory
- **Organizational Capability** into eGrants *Organizational Capability*
- **Cost effectiveness and Budget Adequacy** into eGrants *Cost Effectiveness and Budget Adequacy*
- **Executive Summary** into eGrants *Executive Summary*.
